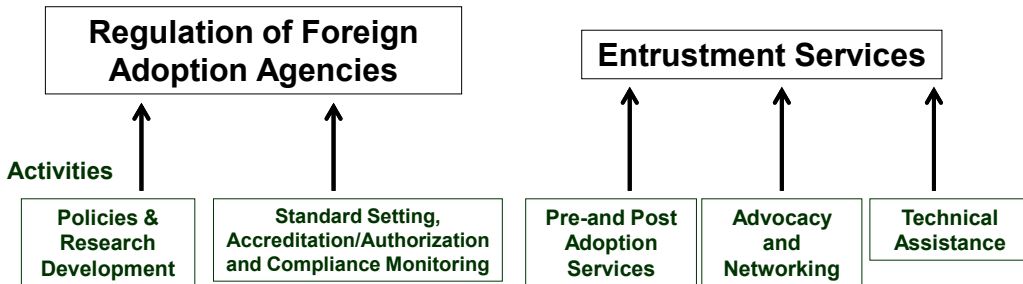

Poverty reduction and empowerment of the poor and vulnerable	Intercountry adoption	The socio-legal process of adopting a child by a foreign national or a Filipino citizen permanently residing abroad where the petition for adoption is filed, the supervised trial custody is undertaken and the Decree of Adoption is issued in the foreign country where the applicant resides thereby creating a permanent parent-child relationship between the child and adoptive parent. (RA 8043 IRR Article II Section 3)

Poverty reduction and empowerment of the poor and vulnerable	Policy Formulation, Advocacy and Networking	A mechanism maximizing the resources of the agency to (a) formulate, and develop policies, programs and services that will protect the Filipino child from abuse, exploitation, trafficking and adoption practices that are harmful, detrimental and prejudicial to the best interests of the child; (b) assist and coordinate with other concerned agencies involved in the process of adoption. (RA 8043 Article II Section 6 Powers of the Board)

Transparent, accountable, and participatory governance	Intercountry Adoption	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Rules and regulations prescribed to carry out the provisions of the Intercountry Adoption Act of 1995 are undertaken after consultation and upon favorable recommendation of the different agencies concerned and involved in intercountry adoption. ▪ Policies, systems and procedures are established and institutionalized to prevent any improper financial gain in connection with adoption and deter improper practices. (RA 8043 Article II Section 6)
